Establish the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.

This unit explores the concept of sequencing in programming through Scratch. It begins with an introduction to the programming environment. They will be introduced to a selection of motion, sound, and event blocks which they will use to create their own programs, featuring sequences. The final project is to make a representation of a piano.
