<p>As well as choosing one activity from this section please ensure you complete the following:</p> <p>Read daily and record in the yellow reading record.</p> <p>Practise weekly spellings using your Ed Shed login.</p>	<p><u>Exploring Destination!</u> Have a look at a map of the world...where would you like to go and explore? Using some research, choose a country or place and describe the destination and what you might see or find if you went there. Let's make a class display of wonderful places across our world!</p>	<p><u>Recommend a fact book to a friend</u> We would like to continue collecting some book recommendations to share 'brilliant books' that others might like to read. This term we are focussing on FACT books (non-fiction)...which ones do you enjoy dipping into and why?</p>
	<p><u>Explorer Fact File</u> Choose an explorer from the past or present. Create a fact file about them. You could include: a picture, where they went, what amazing things they discovered, how they changed the world. Examples: Amelia Earhart, Ibn Battuta, Ellen Macarthur, Tim Peake, Matthew Henson</p>	<p><u>Grammar-Different sentence types</u> We are becoming confident at using different sentence types in our writing this term: Statement Question Exclamation Command Choose some reading (this could be a story, fact book, magazine, comic or newspaper) and see if you can find examples of these 4 different sentences. Remember the punctuation may give you a clue (. ! ?)</p>
	<p><u>Maths Games- TT Rock Stars</u> Use your TT Rock Stars log in (coming home in books) to start to practise multiplication facts.
