| <p>Topic and English Endangered Animals Fact File Research some endangered animals and choose one to make your own fact file about. Website to start from: https://www.worldwildlife.org/species/</p> | <p>Topic and Science Persuasive Recycle, Reuse, Reduce Create a poster to persuade others to Recycle, Reuse and Reduce. Try and include reasons for encouraging people to do the Three Rs. You could do some research and the importance of recycling to include on your poster.</p> | <p>English – Reading - Try a different book We have read LOTS of different books this year. We challenge you to read and enjoy (either one of your own or shared read with a grown up) a type of book you do NOT often think to read. This may be a FACT book on a new topic, or maybe some poems or perhaps a different fiction genre...you might be inspired by a visit to the local library or speak to our librarians for inspiration! | <p>Diary Entry We are looking at writing diary recounts this term. Can you keep your own diary? It doesn't have to be every day but could be if you have a fun or interesting day. You could try to include what you have been doing and how you felt when you did it.</p> | <p>Spellings Don't forget to look at the class website to see what spelling patterns we will be learning. We are also going to focus on a group of spellings each week in our Early Morning activities. We will practise them in school but if the children want to bring them home to practise then they can.</p> | <p>Special Objects In the final part of this term we will be studying a book called 'The Proudest Blue'. We will be thinking about objects that are special to us. Draw or take a picture of an object that is special to you and write a short description about why it is so important to you.</p> |

You could write your findings in a table, tally chart or pictogram (we will be learning more about these charts in maths this term too).</p> | | <p>Science: Create your own animal Topic: Humans and animals. Create your own animal that fits into one of these groups: mammal, amphibian, fish, reptile or bird. Draw the new animal and explain the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What it eats • Where it lives (its habitat) • What its young look like and how they change as they become adults • If it gives birth to live young or an egg • Life expectancy (how long it lives) <p>What it is in a food chain (consumer, herbivore, predator etc</p> |
